# Leveraging IPEDS Data to Examine MacKenzie Scott's \$560 Million Donation to HBCUS

### Abstract

 This session will demonstrate how researchers leveraged IPEDS data to develop profiles of HBCUs who received donations from philanthropist MacKenzie Scott and how those profiles compared to those of HBCUs who did not receive donations.

## The Project

- Rutgers Graduate School of Education Center for Minority Serving Institutions interested in exploring patterns of donations from MacKenzie Scott.
- Wanted to know more about the HBCU schools that received donations from MacKenzie Scott and how they compared to other HBCUs.

### The Data Analysis

- To provide a contextual framework for Rutgers' CMSI, we utilized data from IPEDs to create institutional profiles and comparisons.
- Developed interactive Power BI <u>report</u> that allows users to explore and compare institutional data
  - Institutional data overview
  - Comparison of donation recipients to non-recipients
  - Side by side institutional comparison on key metrics

Over 50 variables used; extracted 8 years of data












Total HBCUs

Percent of full-time first-time undergrads receiving Pell




#### Undergraduate Enrollment




#### Net Revenue per FTE










#### 6-Year Graduation rate - Bachelor degree attainment


